Fund Objective

• Taiping Greater China New Momentum Equity Fund is a SFC authorized fund[#], primarily focusing on our investment niche of the Greater China region, comprising PRC, Hong Kong and Macau markets. The Fund seeks to provide investors with medium to long term capital appreciation.

• Effective from 30 April 2016, the jurisdiction of the Fund (place of domicile) has been changed from Cayman Islands to Hong Kong.

• Effective from 30 June 2016, the Fund may invest less than 30% of its non-cash assets in listed equity securities of companies which may have no connection with the Greater China region. Such equity securities are listed on exchanges worldwide including but not limited to the United States. The Fund may also invest up to 20% of its non-cash assets in A Shares via the Stock Connect.



Fund Manager's Report
Market Review

The fund's NAV went up by 3.8% in this Feb, while the benchmark MSCI Zhonghua Index rose by 4.1% in the same month. The fund advanced by 13.8% year to date, which lagged behind the benchmark index by 1.2 percent points. Mainly due to accommodative monetary policy and rising market risk appetite, global stock market continued to advance in Feb, with S&P 500 Index, Hang Seng Index and Shanghai Shenzhen CSI 300 rose by 3.0%, 2.5% and 14.6% respectively in Feb. Majority of the industries in MSCI Zhonghua Index advanced in Feb, only Communication Services retreated. Information Technology, Consumer Discretionary and Financials outperformed, while Communication Services, Real Estate, Energy and Consumer Staples underperformed.

Market Outlook

On the negative side, NBS manufacturing PMI dropped below 50 for 3 consecutive months, showing that China macroeconomics still face pressure. Besides, corporate earnings see little improvement, and current market consensus on corporate earnings in 2019 is still high and faces downward pressure. On the positive side, a moderately loose monetary policy and proactive fiscal policy of Chinese government would be helpful to stabilize the economy, investor confidence is gradually recovering, and the further inclusion of China A shares into MSCI Index from current 5% to 20% by Nov 2019 will draw more attention of overseas investors to increase asset allocation on China market. We expect the Hong Kong market to remain volatile. We will maintain main position on quality stocks, increase holdings of high yield stocks and Chinese H shares, and focus more on investment opportunities in Communication Services, Information Technology, China Financials and Real Estate sectors.
